General Uniform Requirements

Reach British School has high standards and expectations of wearing the school uniform properly. Having a presentable appearance is an important part of showing self-respect and representing the school in the correct way to the public.

This visible statement of the school is fundamental to the reputation and pride of school every student should share whether in Early Years, Primary or Secondary.

We insist that parents support their children in ensuring they come to school in school uniform every day and that it is in good condition.

Early Years – Pre KG, KG1 and KG2

Swimming Uniform

Swimming costumes and trunks should be of a dark colour without large print if possible.

Hair and Other Accessories

- Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied up.
- Hair accessories should be in keeping with the school colours
- The use of hair dye or colouring is not permitted
- The use of make-up is not permitted
- Jewellery: One pair of studded earring and watch are allowed

Jewellery

Jewellery is considered unsafe for pupils in school (especially for PE and swimming and as such should not be worn). This includes earrings for girls' pierced ears (only one pair of plain stud earrings is acceptable). The school cannot be held responsible for loss or damage.

Mobile Phones & Other Electronics

Toys are permitted in the Early Years with the class teacher's permission. Mobile phones, MP3 players are not permitted in class and will be confiscated until the end of the day if found. Repeat offenders will have their devices confiscated and only returned to a parent.

All devices are brought into school at pupils' own risk. The School cannot be held responsible for any loss or theft.
