



Principals Message

Dear Parents,

A VERY IMPORTANT MESSAGE

On Sunday morning we are going to have a FULL evacuation practice involving all students from KG2 to GRADE 7 and the CIVIL DEFENSE, POLICE, and AMBULANCES.

This is only a practice but you must speak with your children and prepare them for this so there is no panic, they must behave in an orderly manner.

We have trained some teachers as FIRE WARDENS and they will be a vital part of the evacuation.

It is very important that all cars are removed from nearby to school by 8.30am, our security will be told to ask you to move. If any of you are in school when the fire alarm activates then you must follow instructions and assemble at the Fire Assembly point.

It may well be a very noisy 30 minutes as it is as much a practice for the emergency services as it is for us but this is a wonderful opportunity for us to ensure the safety of our students and staff. Please discuss this with your children, our teachers will be doing the same to avoid panic as we would hope to do in a real emergency. It will all be over in 30 minutes but I fully understand if you wish to send your children with a hat on Sunday, we will use as much shade as we can. You must also send them with extra water but this may not be carried with them during the evacuation but will hydrate them afterwards.

I expect your full cooperation in this matter and therefore expect all students to be in school by 7.45am on Sunday. We will post photographs on our website for all of you to see.
