- Provide training that is relevant and helpful in the operation of the school, safety of its staff, students, visitors, contractors and protection of the properties, taking into equal consideration the surrounding environment from any damage be it permanent or temporary.
- Prevent any injury, ill health and damage to property and the environment, or any health and safety issues to the best of its ability.
- Enhance the health and well-being of our staff and students by providing welfare facilities, Safe Operating Procedures, Supervision, Training, and other means.
